SAFER INTERNET DAY

Safer Internet Day 2024 will take place on the 6th of February 2024, with learning based around the theme 'Inspiring change? Making a difference, managing influence and navigating change online'.

Safer Internet Day is the UK's biggest celebration of online safety. Each year the focus is on an online issue or theme that speaks to the things young people are seeing and experiencing online. Teachers will be planning activities that focus on 'Inspiring change' on the 6th February.

The draft East Sussex Local Transport Plan 2024 – 2050, sets out how we will plan and provide transport for people taking every day journeys in East Sussex, which include getting to school, work or for leisure, now and in the future.

The plan recognises factors that are important for journeys to school such as enabling safer and more accessible journeys, the benefits to health and wellbeing



from more active travel, even if this is part for part of your journey or being undertaken on certain days of the week. Many of you will often be combining the school run with other journeys, so undertaking multiple trips, to get to work or for other purposes, so the plan recognises the importance of having a connected transport network.
